RESOLUTION APPROVING UPDATED PRECINCT MAP AND ESTABLISHING POLLING PLACES

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes § 204B.16 require the governing body to each municipality to designate by resolution a polling place for each election precinct that is located within the boundaries of the precinct or within one mile of one of the precinct boundaries; and


WHEREAS, each facility identified meets requirements for polling places as outlined in Minnesota Statutes § 204B.16 subs. 4 – 7; and


WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes § 204B.14, subs. 3 and 4 permit municipalities to make changes to precinct boundaries except after January 1 of a year ending with 0 until after redistricting activities have been concluded, after June 1 of an even numbered year or within ten weeks of an election; and,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of New Brighton that the updated precinct map included as Appendix A is adopted and that the polling places shall be as follows:

- Precinct 1 – New Brighton Community Center (NBCC); 400 10<sup>th</sup> St NW; New Brighton MN 55112
- Precinct 2 – Church of Latter Day Saints; 100 Silver Lake Rd NW; New Brighton MN 55112
- Precinct 3 – St. John the Baptist Catholic Church; 835 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave NW; New Brighton MN 55112
- Precinct 4 – Salem Covenant Church; 2655 5<sup>th</sup> St NW; New Brighton MN 55112
- Precinct 5 – Christ the King Lutheran Church; 1900 7<sup>th</sup> St NW; New Brighton MN 55112
- Precinct 6 – New Brighton Community Church; 1500 29<sup>th</sup> Ave NW; New Brighton MN 55112
- Precinct 7 – Grace Point Church; 2351 Rice Creek Rd; New Brighton MN 55112
- Precinct 8 - Sunny Square Neighborhood Center; 2200 Sunnyside Terrace; New Brighton MN 55112
