# RESOLUTION NUMBER 17.63 RESOLUTION AMENDING REGULAR MEETING SCHEDULE OF BOARD OF MANAGERS OF THE LAKE WASHINGTON SANITARY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Managers of Lake Washington Sanitary District (the "District") has adopted By-laws for the District ("By-laws"); and

WHEREAS, Subdivision c of Section 2.8 of the By-laws provides that meetings of the Board of Managers are to be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Mondays of each month; and

WHEREAS, Article 9 of the By-laws permits the By-Laws to be amended by resolution approved by four-fifths (4/5) of the Board's members; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Managers of Lake Washington Sanitary District (the "District") has codified ordinances for the District ("Ordinances"); and

WHEREAS, Section 3.4.7, subdivision c of the Ordinances provides that meetings of the Board of Managers are to be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Mondays of each month; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Managers desires to reduce its meeting frequency from twice per month to once per month.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Managers of the District, as follows:

- 1. That Subdivision c of Section 2.8 of the By-laws shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:
  - "c. <u>Regular Meetings</u>. The Board will hold regular monthly meetings on the 2nd Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the District's official meeting place, or at such other place as the Board may determine by resolution."
- 2. That the Board of Managers of the District adopts and ordains Ordinance No. 3.4.12, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
  - 3. That Ordinance No. 3.4.12 shall be effective upon publication.
- 4. That notice of this resolution shall be disseminated and posted by the Secretary of the Lake Washington Sanitary District pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statute § 442A.15.
