Proclamation

- WHEREAS: September 17, 2018, marks the two hundred and thirty-first anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and
- WHEREAS: The Constitution is the framework for American self-governance, and creates fundamental limitations on the government power that protect the inalienable rights of U.S. Citizens; and
- WHEREAS: Congress passed Pub. L. 105-225 in 1998, directing the President to issue a proclamation designating September 17-23 as Constitution Week; and
- WHEREAS: Congress further invited the people of the United States to observe Constitution Week, in schools, churches, and other suitable places, with appropriate ceremonies and activities; and
- WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 17-23, 2018 as:

CONSTITUTION WEEK

in the State of Minnesota.
