### TO ALL SHERIFFS, PEACE OFFICERS, AND OTHER CIVIL OFFICERS STATE OF MINNESOTA

Whereas, it has been made known to me by the Governor of the State of **South Dakota** that **MYLON TODD AMMANN** (the "fugitive") stands charged by indictment and information with **felony Driving Under Influence, misdemeanor Failure to Maintain Financial Responsibility, misdemeanor Expired License Sticker, and misdemeanor Open Container**, was present in the State of **South Dakota** at the time of commission of the crimes, has fled from the State of **South Dakota**, and is now a fugitive from justice, and may now be found in the State of **Minnesota**;

Whereas, the Governor of the State of **South Dakota**, pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the United States, and the laws of the State of **Minnesota** and the State of **South Dakota**, has demanded that I cause the fugitive to be arrested and delivered to **Sheriff Michael Milstead, agent of the State of South Dakota**, and/or authorized designee(s), who is/are authorized to receive the fugitive and to transport the fugitive to the State of **South Dakota**, to be dealt with according to law;

Whereas, the demand and supporting documents are duly certified as authentic by the Governor of the State of **South Dakota**.

Now, Therefore, I, Tim Walz, Governor of the State of **Minnesota**, issue this Warrant commanding all sheriffs, peace officers, and other civil officers of this State, to arrest and aid and assist in arresting **MYLON TODD AMMANN** and to deliver the fugitive to the designated agent(s) in order that the fugitive may be taken back to the State of **South Dakota** to be dealt with according to law.
