## ORDINANCE NO. 29 SEVENTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LITTLE FALLS AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 2, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION AND GENERAL GOVERNMENT", BY AMENDING SECTION 2.01, ENTITLED "CITY COUNCIL", PARAGRAPH A., ENTITLED "WARD BOUNDARIES" AND ADOPTING BY REFERENCE LITTLE FALLS CITY CODE CHAPTER 1 AND SECTION 1.99, WHICH AMONG OTHER THINGS CONTAINS PENALTY PROVISIONS

## THE CITY OF LITTLE FALLS ORDAINS:

**SECTION 1**. Little Falls City Code Chapter 2 entitled "Administration and General Government", Section 2.01, entitled "City Council", Paragraph A entitled "Ward Boundaries", is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

- A. Ward Boundaries: Three (3) wards have been established with the following boundaries:
- 1. First Ward/Precinct: The First Ward shall consist All property within the City of Little Falls, lying southerly and easterly of a line drawn from the intersection of the south City limits and the centerline of First Street Southeast; thence northerly along the centerline of First Street Southeast to the intersection of the centerline of State Highway 27; thence westerly along the centerline of State Highway 27 to the center of the Mississippi River; thence northeasterly along the centerline of the Mississippi River to the intersection with the extension westerly of the centerline of Fourth Avenue Northeast; thence easterly along the centerline of Fourth Avenue Northeast and its extension easterly to the easterly right-of-way of US Highway 10 and Trunk Highway 371; thence northerly along the easterly right-of-way of US Highway 10 and Trunk Highway 371 and continuing northerly along the easterly right-of-way of Trunk Highway 371 to the north line of Section 13, Township 41, Range 32 and there ending.
- 2. Second Ward/Precinct: The Second Ward shall consist of all the property within the City of Little Falls lying easterly of the Mississippi River and lying northerly and westerly of the following described line: commencing at the centerline of the Mississippi River and the intersection with the extension westerly of the centerline of Fourth Avenue Northeast; thence easterly along the centerline of Fourth Avenue Northeast and its extension easterly to the easterly right-of-way of US Highway 10 and Trunk Highway 371; thence northerly along the easterly right-of-way of US Highway 10 and Trunk Highway 371 and continuing northerly along the easterly right-of-way of Trunk Highway 371 to the north line of Section 13, Township 41, Range 32 and there ending
- 3. Third Ward/Precinct: The Third Ward shall consist of all property within the City of Little Falls lying westerly of the following described line: commencing at the intersection of the south City limits and the centerline of First Street Southeast; thence northerly along the centerline of First Street Southeast to the intersection of the centerline of State Highway 27; thence westerly along the centerline of State Highway 27 to the center of the Mississippi River; thence northeasterly along the centerline of the Mississippi River to the intersection with the north City limits and there ending.

**SECTION 2.** For illustrative purposes, a map showing said precincts is hereby included.

**SECTION 3**. These ward changes are being made pursuant under Minnesota Statutes 204B.14, Subdivision 3(d) which requires that precinct boundaries must be reestablished within 60 days of when the legislature has been redistricted or at least 19 weeks before the State Primary election, whichever comes first.

**SECTION 4**. Polling places for each ward shall remain the same as designated in Resolution 2022-21 and as amended from time to time by resolution, by the City Council of the City of Little Falls on March 7, 2022.

**SECTION 5**. Little Falls City Code Chapter 1, entitled "General Provisions, Definitions and Penalty", and Section 1.99, entitled "Penalties for Each Offense", is hereby adopted in its entirety by reference as though repeated verbatim herein.

**SECTION 6**. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect seven (7) days after its passage and with its publication.
