# 2022 STATE CANVASSING BOARD CERTIFICATE State Primary

On August 16, 2022, we the undersigned legally constituted State Canvassing Board (hereinafter "Board") canvassed the certified copies of the County Canvassing Board Reports received from the County Auditors which report the votes cast at the August 9, 2022 State Primary Election for United States Representative, State Senator, State Representative, Governor and Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, and Attorney General, as required by Minnesota Statutes section 204C.32. We have specified in the following report the names of persons reported as receiving votes and the number received by each in the several counties in which they were cast. Based on this report, the Board makes the following declarations:

#### State and Federal - Partisan Offices

The Board hereby declares that the candidates in multi-county districts from each of the Grassroots-Legalize Cannabis Party, the Legal Marijuana Now Party, the Republican Party, and the Democratic-Farmer-Labor Party receiving the most votes for the offices of United States Representative, State Senator, State Representative, Governor and Lieutenant Government, Secretary of State, and Attorney General are nominated as the candidates for the Grassroots-Legalize Cannabis Party, Legal Marijuana Now Party, Republican Party, and Democratic-Farmer-Labor Party respectively.
