### TO ALL SHERIFFS, PEACE OFFICERS, AND OTHER CIVIL OFFICERS STATE OF MINNESOTA

**Whereas**, it has been made known to me by the Governor of the State of **Virginia** that **Danilo Salazar Cortes a/k/a Daniel Salazar a/k/a Danilo Cortes a/k/a Danilo Salazar a/k/a Danny Salazar a/k/a Danny Salazar Cortes** (“the fugitive”) was charged by affidavit and warrant with **misdemeanor Stalking**, was present in the State of **Virginia** at the time of commission of the crime, has since fled from the jurisdiction of the State of **Virginia**, and is now a fugitive, and may now be found in the State of **Minnesota**.

**Whereas**, the Governor of the State of **Virginia**, pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the United States, and the laws of the State of **Minnesota** and the State of **Virginia**, has demanded that I cause the fugitive to be arrested and delivered to **Fairfax County Sheriff Stacey A. Kincaid** and/or authorized designee(s), who is/are authorized to receive the fugitive and to transport the fugitive to the State of **Virginia**, to be dealt with according to law.

**Whereas**, the demand and supporting documents are duly certified as authentic by the Governor of the State of **Virginia**.

**Now, therefore**, I, Tim Walz, Governor of the State of **Minnesota**, issue this Warrant commanding all sheriffs, peace officers, and other civil officers of this State, to arrest and aid and assist in arresting the fugitive and to deliver the fugitive to the designated agent(s) in order that the fugitive may be taken back to the State of **Virginia** to be dealt with according to law.
