Proclamation

WHEREAS: Minnesota women use their talents, skills, abilities, and sense of justice and commitment to express themselves in a wide variety of activities in communities all over Minnesota, but are not always recognized for the positive contributions they make; and

WHEREAS: The Marvelous Minnesota Woman Award honors women for their personal accomplishments and acknowledges the significance of each individual contribution to the community; and

WHEREAS: Sue Abderholden, of Minneapolis, has a career in the public health area, primarily as an advocate for retarded citizens of Minnesota which has led her to believe that raising a child with a disability is a feminist issue because it is mothers who most often carry the greater responsibility of child care and family management; and

WHEREAS: Sue Abderholden is an active feminist and political activist who has used her career and community/political activities to enlighten legislators, other professionals and community members about the equal rights for women and to identify the specific institutional barriers to equity and to correct them;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ARNE H. CARLSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

SUE ABDERHOLDEN

to be a MARVELOUS MINNESOTA WOMAN in recognition of her professional accomplishments and the example she sets for young women, which exemplifies the leadership and organizational skills of Minnesota women.
