WHEREAS:	Mahsa was 22 years old when she was arrested and accused of violating Iran's mandatory dress code; and
WHEREAS:	Mahsa spent three days in a coma before Iranian officials announced she had died on September 16, 2022; and
WHEREAS:	Women and children have led protests across the globe in response to Mahsa's death, demanding social freedom and political change; and
WHEREAS:	Minnesota's Iranian-American community has demonstrated their unwavering support for the people of Iran, many of whom are their relatives, and have experienced arrests and injuries during recent protests; and
WHEREAS:	Minnesota acknowledges the expressions of concern and support from its Iranian-American community and recognizes their calls for justice and peace in Iran.
