Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The Federal Aviation Administration and employees have made the United States Air Traffic System the safest worldwide; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota has emerged as a leader in aviation by encouraging and supporting Air Traffic and Aviation related industries; and
- WHEREAS: The Federal Aviation Administration and the State of Minnesota have entered into a partnership of aviation education programs, creating an environment of learning and cooperation to build a sturdy foundation for the future air traffic system; and
- WHEREAS: Minneapolis Tower encourages and supports educational and cooperative programs giving college students hands-on air traffic experience. The majority continue on to become Full Performance Level Controllers in the Air Traffic System; and
- WHEREAS: Minneapolis Tower handles over 500,000 aircraft operations annually in a safe and expeditious manner, with the flow of aircraft as the primary responsibility; and
- WHEREAS: Minneapolis Tower recognizes and hires handicapped individuals who demonstrate the skill and desire to perform duties associated with the support of the air traffic system. Additionally, the controllers at Minneapolis Tower actively recruit women and minorities for Air Traffic Screening; and
- WHEREAS: Minneapolis Tower is being recognized on June 13, 1991 with the FAA's "1990 National Radar Facility of the Year" for its outstanding safety record and service to the flying public;
