Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Lesbian Visibility Day began in Los Angeles in the 1990s as a grassroots effort to celebrate lesbians and challenge harmful stereotypes towards LGBTQ+ women and nonbinary people; and in 2020 Lesbian Visibility Week was formally launched in the United Kingdom; and
- WHEREAS: Lesbian Visibility Week celebrates the vibrant diversity and contributions of lesbian, queer, and nonbinary individuals within our communities; and
- WHEREAS: The official theme of the 2025 Lesbian Visibility Week is “Celebrating Rainbow Families,” emphasizing the importance of unity while recognizing and uplifting the unique experiences of LGBTQ+ women and their families; and
- WHEREAS: Lesbian Visibility Week seeks to amplify the voices of LGBTQ+ women and nonbinary people, ensuring that their stories are heard, and their experiences acknowledged; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota is committed to fostering a diverse, inclusive, and equitable environment where all individuals are celebrated for their authentic selves; and
- WHEREAS: All people are encouraged to join in recognizing the lives and contributions of lesbian women and nonbinary individuals, and to support efforts to create a more inclusive society for all.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 21-27, 2025, as:

LESBIAN VISIBILITY WEEK

in the State of Minnesota.
