445 Minnesota St., St. Paul, Minnesota, for the term
beginning from the 1st day of April, 2003 and until his/her successor is duly
qualified.

Now, therefore, after the granting of such appointment as Deputy Registrar, the principal and each of its
employees, agents or representatives, shall faithfully observe all the laws of the State of Minnesota and of the
United States of America, and shall pay all damages suffered by any person by reason of the violation of any
such laws by the principal or its employees, agents or representatives, or by the commission of any willful or

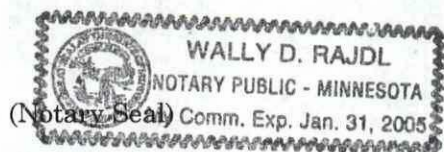

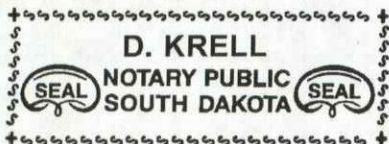
