COMPLAINT

The Complainant, being duly sworn, makes complaint to the above-named Court and states that there is probable cause to believe that the Defendant committed the following offense(s). The complainant states that the following facts establish PROBABLE CAUSE:

Your Complainant, Louis Stuvland, is a Sergeant with the Moorhead Police Department. Your Complainant states that he has been informed by Officer Brun, also of the Moorhead Police Department, that at about 5:43 p.m. on July 16, 1990, Officer Brun was dispatched to 1815 9th Avenue South in Moorhead upon a complaint of a person entering an apartment and taking a TV. While on the way, Park Ranger Landsem found the vehicle, a 1978 blue Dodge with Minnesota license plate in the TLC lot. This was the description of the vehicle given by a witness to the burglary. Officer Bergquist and Officer Brun arrived and found a male subject inside which matched the description given of the suspect. This person was later identified as THOMAS RAY JACKSON, hereinafter referred to as the Defendant. The Defendant indicated that he had been driving the Dodge, which belonged to one Frank Charon. The Defendant further indicated that he had picked up the TV from the apartment of one Douglas Stensgard for some money which was owed to him. The Defendant indicated the VCR was his.

The Defendant indicated that he was going to pawn the TV for money owed him by Stensgard and stated that Stensgard could get the TV back later from the pawn shop. The Defendant stated that Stensgard had agreed to let him take the TV two days earlier, and further stated that he had told the Defendant just to go in and pick it up.

Officer Brun attempted to contact Stensgard, but he was not listed in the book.

Subsequently, Officer Brun contacted Stensgard. Stensgard stated that he knew the Defendant but did not give him permission to take a TV. He indicated that he had had the Defendant work for him before but there had been problems with missing property in the apartments the Defendant worked in. He, Stensgard, indicated that the Defendant no longer worked for him.

WHEREFORE, your Complainant complains as follows:

COUNT I

That on or about July 16, 1990, in the City of Moorhead, County of Clay and State of Minnesota, one THOMAS RAY JACKSON willfully, wrongfully, unlawfully, feloniously and intentionally entered a building without consent and with intent to commit a crime, or entered a building without consent and committed a crime while in the building, and that the building was a dwelling, to wit: entered the residence at 1815 9th Avenue South and stole a TV set from within the apartment, the said acts constituting the following described:

OFFENSE: BURGLARY IN THE SECOND DEGREE
STATUTE: 609.582, Subd. 2
PENALTY: 0-10 years and/or \$20,000

COUNT II

That on or about July 16, 1990, in the City of Moorhead, County of Clay and State of Minnesota, one THOMAS RAY JACKSON willfully, wrongfully, unlawfully, feloniously and intentionally entered a building without consent and with intent to steal or commit any felony or gross misdemeanor while in the building, or that he entered the building without consent and stole or committed a felony or gross misdemeanor while in the building, to wit: entered Apartment 1 of 1815 South 9th Avenue in Moorhead and stole a television set from within, the said acts constituting the following described:
