- WHEREAS: Greater awareness of the dangers of food borne illnesses have made the safety of our food supply a growing issue for consumers in Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Education is an important tool in the ongoing effort to improve the safety of food prepared in the home and by restaurants and food services; and
- WHEREAS: The month of September has been set aside as a time to inform and educate consumers about food safety issues;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ARNE H. CARLSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of September 1998 to be
