TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) for the payment of which, we bind ourselves, our  
heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns firmly by these presents.

WHEREAS a master plumber's license has been issued by the Oblige to the above Principal;  
and WHEREAS Minnesota Statutes, section 326.40, subdivision 2, requires a bond for all  
plumbing work entered into with the state.

NOW, THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is such that, if undersigned Principal or  
such persons authorized to perform plumbing under the Principal's supervision performs  
plumbing in compliance with the plumbing codes as required pursuant to Minnesota Rules,  
Chapter 4715, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise, it shall remain in  
full force and effect for a period not to exceed one year ending December 31st. The  
period of this bond is July 13, 2000 through December 31, 2000.  
During the term of this obligation, the Principal and Surety will pay unto the Oblige, or  
as otherwise directed by the Oblige, the amount needed to correct noncomplying plumbing  
work, not to exceed TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) for the benefit of persons  
injured or suffering financial loss by reason of failure to comply with the requirements  
of the plumbing code, Minnesota Rules, Chapter 4715.

FURTHERMORE, it is understood and agreed that:

1. The aggregate liability of the Surety hereunder pertains to all claims arising during  
the period defined above.
2. In the event the bond does not provide for correction of all noncomplying plumbing  
work, the bond paid by the undersigned Surety does not relieve the undersigned Principal  
of liability for correcting noncomplying plumbing work by said Principal or persons  
working under said Principal's supervision.
3. This bond is a continuous obligation which may be canceled at any time as to further  
liability upon the Surety's giving at least fifteen (15) days written notice to the  
Commissioner of Health. In the event of cancellation, the Surety shall not be discharged  
from any liability already accrued under this bond, or which shall accrue hereunder before  
the expiration of the fifteen (15) day notice period.

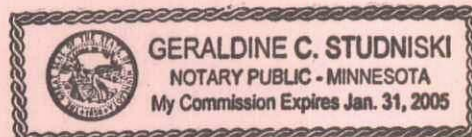

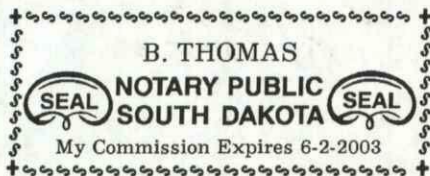
