- WHEREAS: One in every eight American women will develop breast cancer; and
- WHEREAS: Breast cancer kills every eleven minutes, claiming more than 46,000 lives annually; and
- WHEREAS: Breast cancer is 90% curable when detected in its earliest stages; and
- WHEREAS: RACE FOR THE CURE is a unique event, conceived, designed and implemented by the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation to promote positive awareness, education and early detection of breast cancer; and
- WHEREAS: The RACE FOR THE CURE has proven to be an enormously effective way to reach many women with the message that breast cancer is not necessarily fatal if mammography and breast self-examination become routine; and
- WHEREAS: RACE FOR THE CURE/TWIN CITIES is an opportunity for thousands of women and men, running, walking and wheeling, to support the fight against breast cancer in this community; and
- WHEREAS: RACE FOR THE CURE/TWIN CITIES proceeds will fund necessary diagnostic procedures for local, medically underserved women who have problem mammograms as well as contribute to national breast cancer research;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ARNE H. CARLSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, May 9, 1993 to be
