- WHEREAS: On July 6, 1947, the City of Worthington dedicated its Municipal Airport to the memory of all Nobles County Veterans of World War II; and
- WHEREAS: Nobles County Veterans fought for our country's freedom during this and many other wars; and
- WHEREAS: Many of these veterans also gave their lives for our nation, became prisoners of war, or were missing in action; and
- WHEREAS: This year is the fiftieth anniversary of Worthington Municipal Airport's dedication to the World War II veterans; and
- WHEREAS: It is only appropriate to remember all Nobles County Veterans and rededicate the airport to veterans of all wars;

NOW, THEREFORE I, ARNE H. CARLSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 26, 1997 to be
