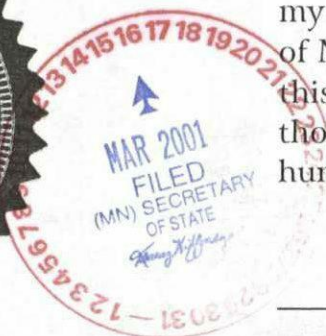
Proclamation
