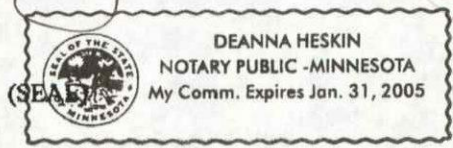

POWER OF ATTORNEY

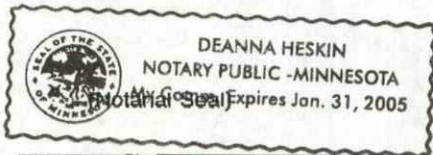
