WHEREAS: National Radiologic Technology Week focuses on the safe medical radiation environment provided through the skilled and conscientious efforts of radiologic technologists.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM PAWLENTY, Governor of Minnesota, proclaim the week of November 6-12, 2005, to be:
