
13 2500.3100 INACTIVE ACUPUNCTURE REGISTRATION.

14 A Minnesota licensed chiropractor who has converted a
15 Minnesota license to inactive may apply to the board for an
16 inactive acupuncture registration. An inactive acupuncture
17 registration is intended for those chiropractors who will be in
18 active practice elsewhere. Upon approval of an application, the
19 board will modify the annual acupuncture registration
20 certificate to indicate inactive registration.

21 2500.3200 ANNUAL RENEWAL OF INACTIVE ACUPUNCTURE REGISTRATION.

22 A registrant must complete an annual renewal application
23 and submit the annual renewal fee for an inactive acupuncture
24 registration ~~in-part-2500-1150~~ as authorized under Minnesota
25 Statutes, section 148.108.

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1 2500.3300 REINSTATEMENT OF INACTIVE ACUPUNCTURE REGISTRATION.

2 Subpart 1. Generally. An inactive acupuncture
3 registration may be reinstated to an active acupuncture
4 registration according to items A to C:

5 A. completion of a board-approved application of
6 reinstatement;

7 B. payment of a reinstatement fee ~~in-part-2500-1150~~
8 as authorized under Minnesota Statutes, section 148.108; and

9 C. submission of a notarized statement from the
10 doctor stating that the registrant has completed two hours of
11 continuing education credits in acupuncture or
12 acupuncture-related subjects as approved by the board for each
13 year the registration was inactive.

14 Subp. 2. Denial. If any of the requirements of subpart 1,
15 items A to C, are not met by the doctor, the board shall deny
16 approval of the application for reinstatement. A person who
17 maintains an inactive acupuncture registration will not be
18 required to take the NBCE acupuncture examination for the
19 purposes of reinstatement.
