DETAILS: To exercise and perform all of the powers and duties imposed upon and vested in the Chief Administrative Law Judge relating to the administration and management of the Office of Administrative Hearings, including administrative hearings conducted for all agencies, boards, commissions, or political subdivisions of the State of Minnesota, which shall include the authority to schedule and assign cases for hearing, sign subpoenas, hear motions to consolidate and order consolidation of hearings, to hear argument upon the filing of an affidavit of prejudice on an Administrative Law Judge, to review rules for substantial changes or other defects; to sign all contracts, purchase orders, requisitions, fiscal, personnel and payroll documents, and all other administrative forms necessary for the day-to-day operation of the Office; to approve special expenses as set forth in the Office of Administrative Hearings Procedures for Review and Approval of Special Expenses; to exercise and perform all of the powers and duties imposed upon and vested in the Chief Administrative Law Judge relating to the Workers' Compensation Section of the Office of Administrative Hearings, including the direct supervision of the Compensation Judges; and all powers and duties imposed by Minn. Stat. Ch. 176 and rules adopted thereunder.
