teens become pregnant; and

attention to the issue of teen pregnancy and to highlight the need for comprehensive, effective teen pregnancy prevention programs; and

WHEREAS: Working together, all members of a community can provide the information

and support necessary to affirm positive choices that young people can make to

avoid early pregnancy, finish high school and enjoy happy fulfilling lives.

Now, Therefore, I, TIM PAWLENTY, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2005, as:
