4 6133.0030 GAME BIRDS.

5 The restitution values for game bird species are as follows:

6 [For text of items A to O, see M.R.]

7 P. canvasback, ~~\$200~~ \$100;

8 Q. geese, \$50;

9 R. tundra swan, \$200; and

10 S. trumpeter swan, ~~\$3,000~~ \$1,000.

11 6133.0080 GAME FISH.

12 Subpart 1. **General.** Except for fish covered in subparts 2 and 3, the values in this
13 subpart apply. For fish species that do not have a designated quality size, or for fish that
14 have a total length equal to or less than the designated quality size, the restitution value
15 is the base value shown in the following table. For fish that have a length that exceeds
16 the designated quality size, the restitution value is the base value plus \$10 for every inch
17 over the quality size.

22 Subp. 2. **Muskellunge.** Except as provided in subpart 3, item D, the restitution values
23 for muskellunge are as follows:

24 A. θ 4 to less than 30 inches, \$40;

25 B. 30 to less than 40 inches, \$200;

26 C. 40 to less than 50 inches, \$500; and

27 D. 50 inches and over, \$1,000 plus \$100 for each inch over 50 inches.

28 Subp. 3. Game fish less than four inches. The restitution values for fish that are less
29 than four inches in length are as follows:

30 A. green or orange spotted sunfish less than four inches in length, no value;

31 B. yellow perch and members of the Centrarchidae family (bluegill, pumpkinseed,
32 longear sunfish, warmouth, hybrid sunfish, black bass, rock bass, and crappie), except
33 for green or orange spotted sunfish, that are less than four inches in length, ten cents per
34 fish;

1 C. walleye taken on Lake Superior or in St. Louis bay that are less than two inches
2 in length, ten cents per fish; and

3 D. all other game fish that are less than four inches in length and not included in
4 items A to C, \$1 per fish.

5 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** The amendments to parts 6133.0030 and 6133.0080 are effective
6 March 1, 2003.
