

WHEREAS: Lance Corporal Kyle Anderson graduated in 2003 from Simley High School in Inver Grove

Heights; and

WHEREAS: Lance Corporal Anderson joined the United States Marine Corps in the summer of 2003

and graduated from basic training at the top of his class; and

WHEREAS: Lance Corporal Anderson was deployed in Iraq when on October 11, 2004, a bomb

exploded near Fallujah and shrapnel tore through his helmet and the left side of his skull;

and

WHEREAS: Lance Corporal Anderson suffered brain damage and emerged from a coma just before

New Year's Day. He remains hospitalized in the VA Medical Center at Fort Snelling and is

making impressive strides in his recovery; and

WHEREAS: Lance Corporal Anderson's combat service record in Iraq is distinguished, and he is

credited with saving the life of a wounded corporal after an insurgent attack; and

WHEREAS: On Thursday, June 23, 2005, there will be a welcome home ceremony and Purple Heart

medal presentation for Lance Corporal Kyle Anderson at Simley High School; and

WHEREAS: The Purple Heart is awarded in the name of the President of the United States to members

of the Armed Forces who are wounded in action against an enemy force or while being

held as a prisoner of war; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota thanks Lance Corporal Kyle Anderson for the many sacrifices he

endured in order to receive this prestigious medal. Our thoughts and prayers will continue

to be with him on his road to recovery.
