Resident plan of care. "Resident plan of care" 9 for residents of nursing facilities means the comprehensive care 10 plan as set forth in Code of Federal Regulations, title 42, 11 section 483.20, paragraph (d), as amended through October 1, 12 1992. 13 [For text of subps 13 and 14, see M.R.] 14 9549.0059 RESIDENT ASSESSMENT. 15 Subpart 1. Assessment of nursing facility applicants and 16 newly admitted residents. Each nursing facility applicant or 17 newly admitted resident must be assessed for the purpose of 18 determining the applicant's or newly admitted resident's class. 19 The assessment must be conducted according to the procedures in 20 items A to I. 21 [For text of items A to G, see M.R.] 22 Except as provided in item D, each assessment H. 23 completed under items A to G and a completed medical plan of 24 care or interagency transfer form must be submitted to the 25 Department of Health by the nursing facility as a request for 26 classification within ten working days after admission or after 27 the assessment, whichever is later. 28 [For text of item I, see M.R.] 29 Subp. 2. Semiannual assessment by nursing facilities. 30 Semiannual assessments of residents by the nursing facility must 31 be completed in accordance with items A to D. 32 [For text of item A, see M.R.] 33 A registered nurse shall assess each resident в. 34 according to QA&R procedures established by the Department of 35

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Health including physical observation of the resident, review of 1 the medical plan of care, and review of the resident's plan of 2 care, and shall record the assessment on the assessment form. 3 The Physician's Statement of General Condition (item 10), 4 Individual Dependencies (items 21 to 24 and 28), Medications 5 (items 31 to 34), and Primary, Secondary, and Tertiary Diagnoses 6 (on the back of the form) do not require completion. The 7 registered nurse performing the assessment shall sign the 8 assessment form on the day the assessment is completed. 9

Subp. 3. Change in classification due to annual assessment 11 by Department of Health. Any change in resident class due to an 12 annual assessment by the Department of Health's QA&R team will 13 be effective as of the first day of the month following the date 14 of completion of the Department of Health's assessments. QA&R 15 shall not establish classifications for residents who experience 16 an admission, transfer, hospital return, or discharge occurring 17 during the QA&R team visit. 18

Subp. 4. Assessment upon return to the nursing facility
from a hospital. Residents returning to a nursing facility
after hospitalization must be assessed according to items A to D.

A registered nurse shall perform the assessment on C. 23 each resident according to QA&R procedures established by the 24 Department of Health, including physical observation of the 25 resident, review of the medical plan of care, and review of the 26 resident's plan of care, and shall record the assessment on the 27 assessment form. The registered nurse who performs the 28 assessment shall sign the assessment form. Within five working 29 days of the completion of the assessment, the nursing facility 30 must forward to the Department of Health a request for a 31 classification for any resident assessed upon return to the 32 nursing facility after a hospital admission. This request must 33 include the assessment form and the resident's medical plan of 34 care or interagency transfer form. Upon request, the nursing 35 facility must furnish the Department of Health with additional 36
