MINUTES
STATE CANVASSING BOARD

January 3, 2006

1. Call to Order

Secretary of State Mary Kiffmeyer called the State Canvassing Board to order at 2:43 PM. Other members present who were introduced by Secretary Kiffmeyer, included Associate Justice Alan C. Page, Minnesota Supreme Court, Associate Justice Helen M. Meyer, Minnesota Supreme Court, Judge Gregory G. Galler, Tenth District Court, Judge Susan R. Miles, Tenth District Court. Also present were Assistant Attorney General Christie Eller, Business and Legal Analyst Bert Black, Elections Supervisor Mike McCarthy and other staff of the Office of the Secretary of State.

2. Approval of the November 29, 2005, State Canvassing Board Minutes

After review of these minutes, Tenth District Court Judge Gregory Galler moved that the minutes be approved as submitted. Associate Justice Helen Meyer seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Secretary Kiffmeyer called the question and the motion was adopted unanimously.

3. Presentation of Canvass Report for the December 27, 2005, Special Election, State Senator, Senate District 15.

Secretary Kiffmeyer then recognized Mike McCarthy, Elections Supervisor, who presented the Canvass Report for the two Special Elections held December 27, 2005. Elections Supervisor Mike McCarthy began with the following introductory comments as background to today's canvass report

Noteworthy in this election was a hearing before the Minnesota Supreme Court on the petition of Rick Studer requesting the court to remove the name of Sue Ek, the certified Republican candidate, from the ballot for the election of State Representative from House District 15B to be held on December 27, 2005.

On December 19, 2005, the Court issued an order that included direction that "The Benton, Sherburne, and Stearns County Auditors shall remove the name of Sue Ek from the ballot as a candidate for State Representative for House District 15B ..."

The Court ordered that replacement absentee ballots be provided upon request with instructions stating

“(a) that either a regular absentee ballot or a replacement absentee ballot will be accepted as valid if properly completed and returned,

(b) that votes cast for candidate Ek will not be counted, and

(c) that a returned replacement absentee ballot will replace any absentee ballot the voter may have already have cast.”

The Court further ordered that “If replacement absentee ballots are to be printed for District 15B, the county auditors shall strike the name of Sue Ek from absentee ballots that are provided to voters from District 15B until replacement absentee ballots are available” and that “If a voter casts two absentee ballots, the ballot with the later date on the return envelope shall be counted.”

On December 21, 2005, the Secretary of State’s Office received a written request by Kay Ek to have write-in votes for her counted in the special election for House District 15B. (This is as provided in M.S. 204B.09, Subd. 3)

On December 23, 2005, the Secretary of State’s Office issued supplemental directions to the Benton, Stearns, and Sherburne county auditors for administering the special election in House District 15B consistent with the Court order.

Mr. McCarthy then described the contents of the Canvass Report for State Senator, District 15. The certified results of the individual county canvasses for Benton, Sherburne and Stearns Counties were presented. He reported that as of 7 AM, 3,209 voters were registered in Benton County, 4,616 were registered in Sherburne County and 37,666 voters were registered in Stearns County. There were 25 same day registrations in Benton County, 54 registered in Sherburne County and 370 registered in Stearns County. Benton County received 74 absentee ballots, Sherburne County received 143 absentee ballots, and Stearns County received 810 for a total of 1,027 absentee ballots received. Six hundred thirty seven voters from Benton County, 1,537 from Sherburne County and 9,911 from Stearns County voted in the special election for a total of 12,085 voters.

The Independent Party Candidate Dan Becker received 47 votes from Benton County, 105 votes from Sherburne County, and 674 votes from Stearns County for a total of 826 votes. Republican Candidate Dan “Ox” Ochsner received 212 votes in Benton County, 520 votes in Sherburne County, and 3,690 in Stearns County for a total of 4,422 votes. Democratic-Farmer Labor (DFL) candidate Tarry L Clark received 372 votes in Benton County, 869 votes in Sherburne County, and 5,331 in Stearns County for a total of 6,572 votes. There were 3 write-in votes from Benton County, 12 from Sherburne County and 32 from Stearns County. There were no extraordinary circumstances or reports forwarded from the counties.

4. Approval of Canvass Report for the December 27, 2005 Special Election, State Senator, District 15.

After review of the State Canvass Report for State Senator for District 15, Tenth District Court Judge Susan Miles moved, seconded by Associate Justice Helen Meyer, that the State Canvass Report be approved as presented.

5. Presentation of Canvass Report for the December 27, 2005 Special Election, State Representative, House District 15B.

Mr. McCarthy then described the contents of the Canvass Report for State Representative, House District 15B. The certified results of the individual county canvasses for Benton, Sherburne and Stearns Counties were presented. He reported that as of 7 AM, 3,209 voters were registered in Benton County, 4,616 were registered in Sherburne County and 37,666 voters were registered in Stearns County, for a total of 45,491 voters. There were 25 same day registrations in Benton County, 54 registered in Sherburne County and 125 registered in Stearns County for a total of 203 registrants. Benton County received 74 absentee ballots, Sherburne County received 143 absentee ballots, and Stearns County received 349 for a total of 566 absentee ballots received. Six hundred thirty seven voters from Benton County, 1,537 from Sherburne County and 3,248 from Stearns County voted in the special election for a total of 5,422 voters.

Democratic-Farmer Labor (DFL) candidate Larry Haws received 411 votes in Benton County, 973 votes in Sherburne County, and 2,192 in Stearns County for a total of 3,576 votes. There were 15 write-in votes from Benton County, 30 from Sherburne County and 105 from Stearns County for a total of 150 write-in votes. Write in candidate Kay Ek received 166 votes in Benton County, 415 votes in Sherburne County, and 741 in Stearns County for a total of 1,322 votes. There were no extraordinary circumstances or reports forwarded from the counties.

6. Approval of Canvass Reports

The Secretary invited comments from the participants. Tenth District Court, Judge Susan Miles questioned the discrepancy between the verbal description of 125 Election Day registrations from Stearns County versus the written report reflecting 124. Elections Supervisor Mike McCarthy verified the written report reflected the accurate count.

After clarification and review of the State Canvass Report for State Representative, House District 15B, Associate Justice Alan Page moved, seconded by Associate Justice Helen Meyer, that the State Canvass Report be approved as presented.

There being no further discussion, Secretary Kiffmeyer called the question and the motion was adopted unanimously.

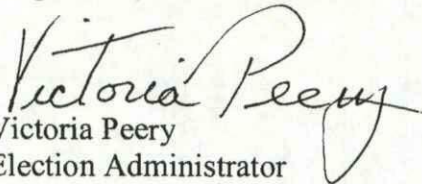
7. Signing of Certification
